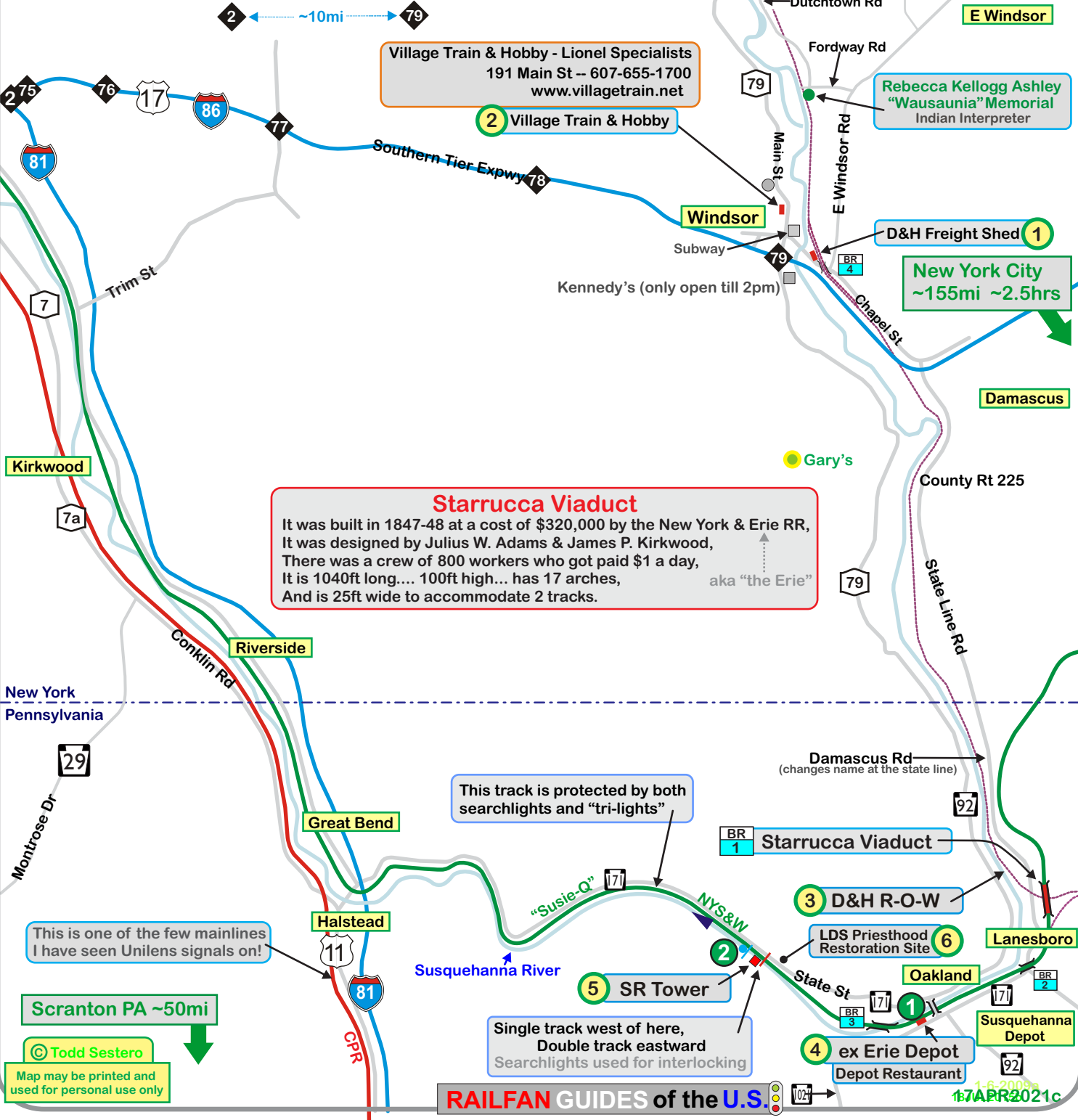

Starrucca Viaduct
 It was built in 1847-48 at a cost of \$320,000 by the New York & Erie RR, It was designed by Julius W. Adams & James P. Kirkwood, There was a crew of 800 workers who got paid \$1 a day, It is 1040ft long.... 100ft high... has 17 arches, And is 25ft wide to accommodate 2 tracks.
 aka "the Erie"

This track is protected by both searchlights and "tri-lights"

This is one of the few mainlines I have seen Unilens signals on!
